LifePoint Kids - Regathering Procedures

- Adventure Point classrooms will be open for ages 6 weeks through Kindergarten. KidsPoint will be open for 1st-4th grade students. Our new MIX56 classroom will be open for 5th-6th grade students. Classrooms will be available at limited capacities to allow for appropriate social distancing.
- LP Kids classes will be only be held during the 10:45 AM service each Sunday. Parents may check in their child(ren) beginning 20 minutes before service/classes begin.
- Registration is not required.
- All children will have their temperature taken before entering the classroom. Any temperature over 100.4 will not be permitted in our kids environments.
- LP Kids workers will be pre-screened and will wear face coverings with a fun, kid-friendly design in order to help put our kids at ease as much as possible.
- During learning time, each child will sit 6 feet away from each other in a hula hoop, or other creative spacing arrangement.
- Toddlers will have their own creative spacing set up in a playpen-type arrangement to allow them to have playtime with others from a safe distance.
- Sinks or appropriate sanitizer stations are available in every classroom to allow our LP Kids volunteers to clean their hands frequently.
- Hand sanitizing stations are located throughout the LP Kids hallway and class rooms for use by children and volunteers.
- Rooms will be cleaned before, during and after all classes.
- All nonessential toys and furnishings will be removed from the rooms. Any items remaining in the classroom space will be appropriately sanitized.
- The pickup and drop off areas will be marked with 6-foot social distancing reminders. Once you've picked up your child, we ask that you exit the check-in/ check-out area as quickly as possible to minimize crowded areas.
- If you choose to bring your children into the Auditorium during the 9:00 AM service when there are no LP Kids classes in session, or during the 10:45 AM service based on your level of comfort, we are making available an activity package for your kids! These items will be packed and available from the LP Greeters as you enter the building.
- Parents, if you have younger children with you in the Auditorium during any service and they become restless, we invite you to use the lobby area of the church or the Overflow Room to meet their needs while you are still able to view the service from either of those areas.
- Regardless of the service you attend, LP Kids is providing lessons created just for your child that will be accessible on the LifePoint Kids Facebook Page and the LP Kids YouTube Channel (search THE GO SHOW LifePoint). Lessons are posted every Sunday before the 9:00 AM service. **If your child will remain with you in the Auditorium, don't forget to bring a tablet or mobile device and a pair of headphones for them to use when listening to their lesson.** This will help us maintain a distraction-free environment.
